PETS ENTERING THE SHELTER IN 2021

SAFE SHELTER - Taking in strays and owner surrendered cats and dogs. Contact our deputies through the non emergency number, (360) 378-4151, to have stray dogs safely transported to the shelter.

ANIMAL TRANSFERS - Taking in cats and dogs from overpopulated shelters across Washington State.

TEAM SAFE - Providing a safe space for pets when an owner is faced with an emergency.

PETS EXITING THE SHELTER IN 2021

PET ADOPTIONS - Adopting displaced cats and dogs to homes able to meet their individual needs.

LOST PETS - Providing safe shelter for lost or stray pets until an owner can be found.

SHELTER SERVICES PROVIDED IN 2021

LOW COST SPAY/NEUTER - Provided for pets whose owners require financial assistance.

MICROCHIPPING - Microchipped pets to improve the likelihood of reunification with an owner when lost.

PET CREMATIONS - Worked with Radiant Heart in Bellingham to provide low cost pet cremation services.

DOG LICENSES - San Juan County requires all dogs be licensed annually. Purchase your license at Orcas APS.

EDUCATION - Offered training resources with the goal of pets and owners living their best lives.

DOG BATHS - Public use of dog washing stations.

FERAL CAT AID - Unaltered cats can multiply quickly. If you suspect a cat to be lost or feral, contact the shelter to learn more about our Trap-Neuter-Return program.

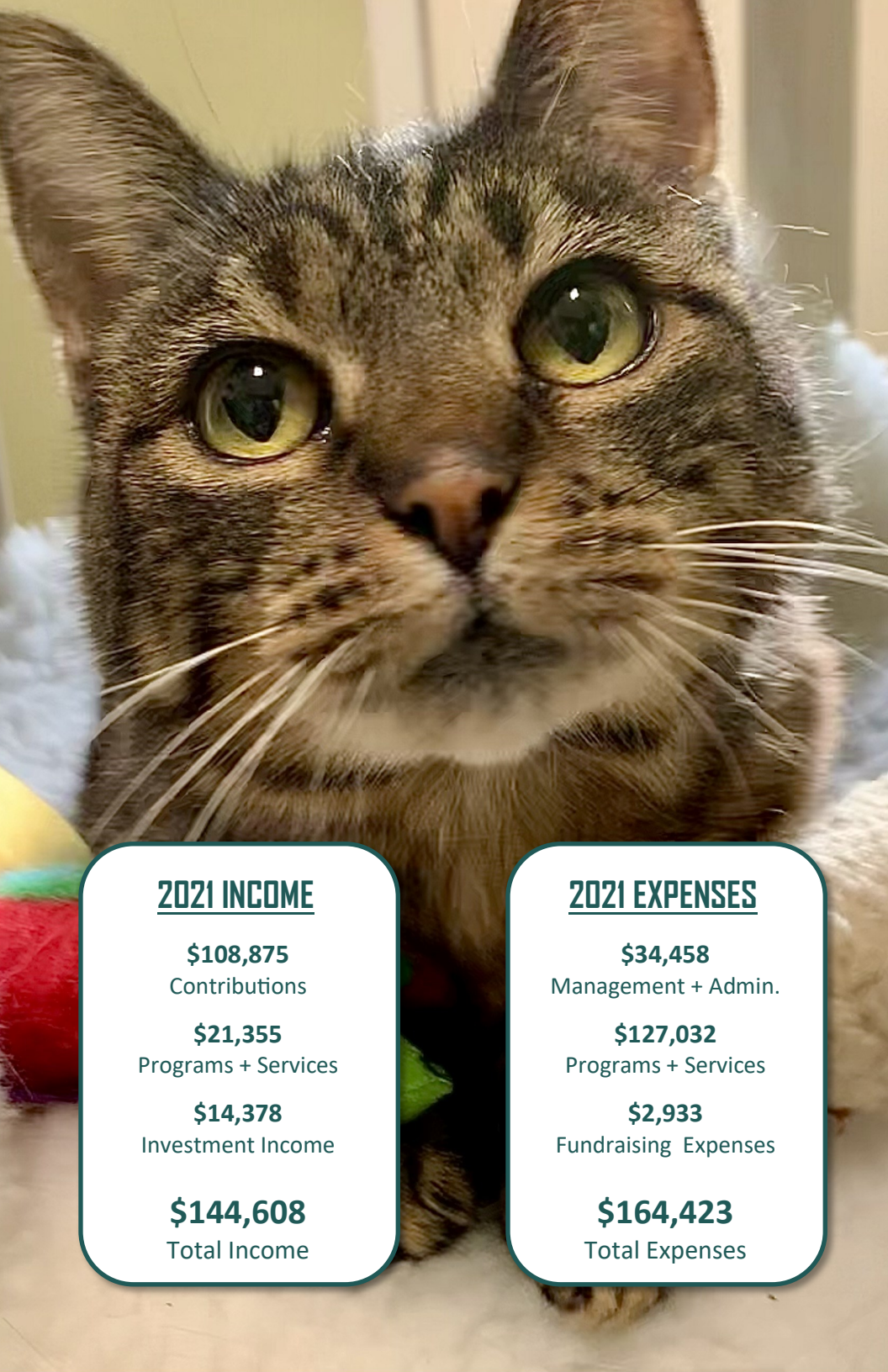

2022 SALTY DOG TREASURE HUNT

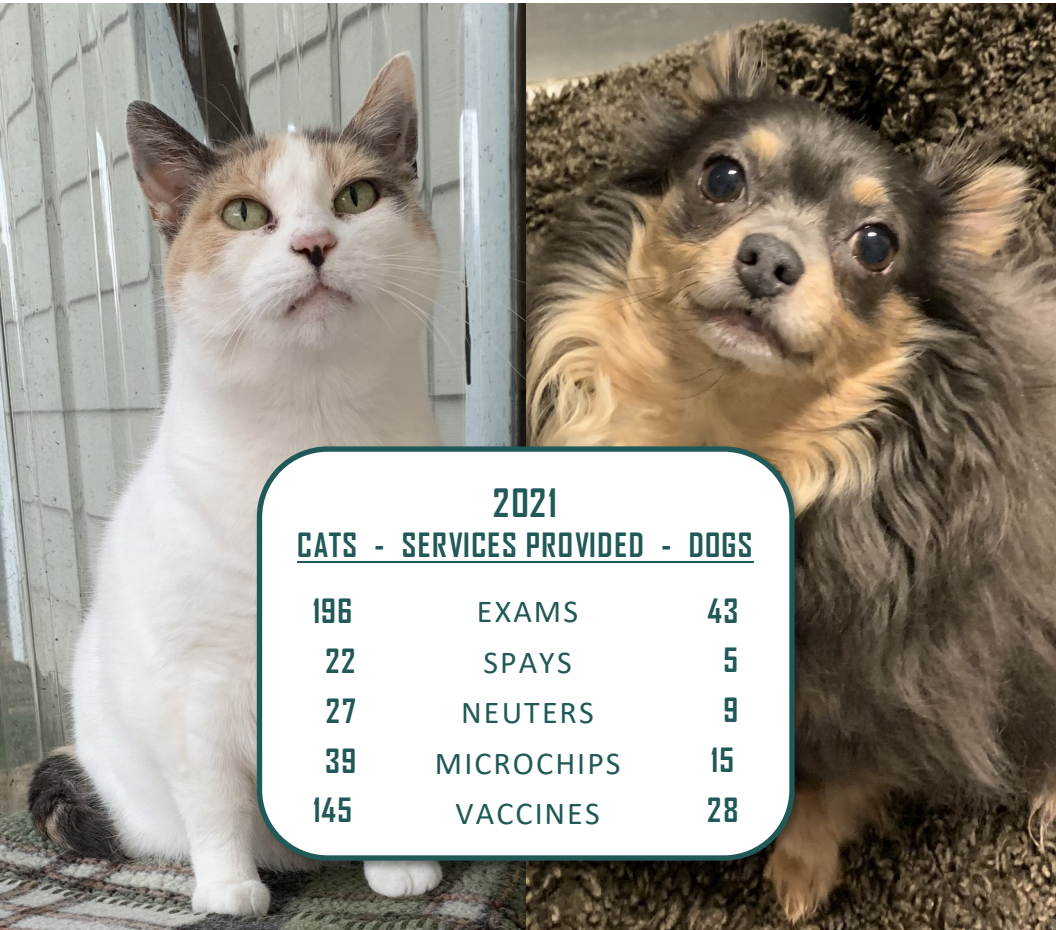

SPAY AND NEUTER TO SAVE LIVES

One of the best ways that you, as a responsible pet owner, can make a difference in the lives of shelter animals is to spay or neuter your pet. Help achieve a no-kill Washington state by reducing the number of accidental litters. Fewer pets in shelters means more lives saved.

Through our Low Cost Spay/Neuter Program, Orcas APS is able to provide dog and cat spays and neuters at a greatly reduced rate to those who qualify. This program is made possible through the generosity of our donors who subsidize the cost.
